Automating Printing of PDF files

Adobe finally fixed the "bug" that prevents automatic printing of PDFs. Here's how to configure you computer to take advantage of automated PDF printing.

Open Adobe Acrobat. Click the Edit menu item and select Preferences (at the bottom of the list). Click the Security (Enhanced) category on the left side of the screen:

Now use the Add Host button to add "<u>www.myfeis.com</u>" to the trusted sites list. Save it (OK button) and close Acrobat.

Now log in to MyFeis and click the Printers button. Set the PDF Auto Print to YES and click the Set PDF Auto Print button.

Go to a scorecard and click the "Print" link. The PDF should open in a new window and print automatically.

Be aware that printing is routed to your default printer, so you will need to have a printer connected or you will need to be able to send your printing to a shared printer at the feis.
